CHAPTER 6.00 – HUMAN RESOURCES

LICENSE OF SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR

Each school bus operator shall possess the minimum qualifications prescribed in School Board Policy, Florida Statutes, State Board of Education rules and other controlling regulations. A school bus operator who attains the age of sixty-five (65) years must pass a semi-annual physical examination administered by a licensed physician as well as the bus driving test administered by the Superintendent's designee.

- (1) All school bus operators shall hold a valid Commercial Driver's License for a Class B vehicle with passenger (P) and school bus (S) endorsements.
- (2) The license shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the school bus or shall be carried by the driver while operating the bus.
- (3) Any school bus operator who should have known that his/her driver's license has expired or has been suspended or revoked and who drives a bus shall be subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.
